BOARD MINUTES

September 11, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Steve Schultz. Board members Denis McLaughlin, Dan Evans and Paul Schultz were present as was Manager, Shane Sheppard. Board member Jeff Bass was absent.

The manager noted Matt Kelly with Simpsons Engineering and Doug Yost Vice President of Acquisitions and Development for Centennial Properties met with the District regarding the Telido Station Development and water infrastructure needs for the development which includes the 90 plus acre's just north of the Freeway. The District's 20-year plan to improve water pressure in the Greenacres service area is to extend another intertie from the Corbin service area north across the freeway along with this development. Centennial Properties has agreed to include the work associated with the development of the Telido Station infrastructure with the District paying for the phase of work which includes the 190 crossing and pressure reducing intertie vault once approved and accepted by the District.
