

**RESOLUTION 2025-11
WATER SYSTEM CAPITALIZATION FEES**

The Board of Directors of Consolidated Irrigation District No. 19 recognizes the following:

WHEREAS, the existing water system was constructed by the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and contributed works by customers and developers over many years; and

WHEREAS, newly constructed domestic, commercial and industrial water services utilize the existing water system; and

WHEREAS, without the prior system development of the distribution mainlines, pumping stations, booster pumping stations and reservoirs, service to new customers would not be possible; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the District that new service customers “buy in” to the system; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the District that capital improvements within the District be funded by new domestic, commercial and industrial customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS BY THE BOARD RESOLVED:

THAT, each new water service installed shall include a onetime capitalization fee at time of installation; and

THAT, the schedule for capitalization fees contained in the attached exhibits may be adjusted from time to time by action of the Board of Directors; and

THAT, the onetime capitalization fee cannot be paid prior to installation freezing any future adjusted capitalization fees adjusted by the Board of Directors; and


THAT, annexed lands will not be assessed a fire line capitalization fee, but will be assessed an annexation equalizing fee based upon the fire line size; and

THAT, the Board of Directors hereby adopts the attached capitalization fee schedule; and

THAT, this resolution supersedes all previous resolutions relating to capitalization fees (Resolution 82-6, 95-7, 95-14, 2002-6 and 2020-5); and

THAT, this resolution shall be effective January 1, 2026.

EXHIBIT "B"

APARTMENTS/MOBILE HOME PARKS

Capitalization Fees are due per apartment and/or per mobile home in mobile home parks where master meters supply water to the entire park. Payment is to be made at the time individual mobile homes are hooked up to water. Fees for apartment complexes are due at time of meter installation and will be collected along with the estimated deposit.

Fee per apartment/mobile home \$200/each
